**1990 MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE (MSW) ACCEPTANCE POLICY - SHORT FORM**

- A. **MSW Acceptance Policy** - household, institutional, and commercial - for waste generated in Morgan County only.
1. Except those items specifically excluded:
    - a. **ALL** tires
    - b. Wet cell batteries
    - c. Large appliances
    - d. Automobile bodies
    - e. Combustion renderings
- B. **"Non-MSW"** - All waste not defined elsewhere herein - including industrial, agricultural, construction/demolition, combustion renderings (ash etc.), and buildings or mobile homes.
1. The following items will be accepted on special fee schedule:
    - a. All tires
    - b. Wet cell batteries
    - c. Large appliances
    - d. Automobile bodies
    - e. Large bulky items
  2. Items accepted or rejected upon application and following special review and approval at higher than standard rates depending upon level of disposal problem caused by specific items.
  3. No "on-demand" acceptance of these items.
- C. Waste from out of county generators may be assessed a surcharge.
- D. Radio Active Materials - not accepted.
- E. Hazardous Waste - not accepted.
- F. Liquid Waste - not accepted.
- G. Sludge - not accepted.

Contractual arrangements/good faith acceptance with commercial and regular users will minimize inspection costs.

Acceptance policy subject to change upon published notice.
