

Notice of General Election-November 8, 2016
To the Electors of Morgan County
Pursuant to C.R.S. §1-5-205

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a General Mail Ballot Election will be held in Morgan County, Colorado on Tuesday, November 8, 2016. Ballots will be mailed to **all active** voters the week of October 17, 2016. Voters may return voted ballots in person to 231 Ensign Street, Fort Morgan, CO during regular business hours of Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. or by mail to PO Box 1399, Fort Morgan, CO 80701.

IMPORTANT: The Affidavit of Voter on the Mail Ballot Envelope **MUST BE SIGNED** by the voter. **Please use black or blue ink ONLY** to mark your ballot. Additionally, on the voter label if there is an "ID" symbol, be sure to enclose a copy of your ID with your ballot. Your ballot will not count unless ID is provided.

All **VOTED** ballots must be returned to the Clerk and Recorder's Office by 7 p.m. on Election Day, November 8, 2016. **Postmarks do not count.** Please affix adequate postage to return ballot by mail.

Sample ballots will be available at the Morgan County Clerk and Recorder's Office at 231 Ensign Street, Fort Morgan, CO or on the website at www.co.morgan.co.us.

Updates to voter registration: To check or change your voter registration, visit www.govotecolorado.com or contact the Morgan County Clerk and Recorder's office at 970-542-3521, option 5. Note that Colorado is a same-day-registration state, which means voters can register or update their voter registration all the way through Election Day at 7 p.m.

If you wish to have a ballot **mailed** to you, the Clerk and Recorder must receive your written application by 4:00 p.m. on Monday, October 31, 2016. Ballots may be obtained by the voter **in person** at the Clerk and Recorder's Office through Monday, November 7, 2016 during regular business hours.

In accordance with EAC Advisory 2007-001: Accessible voting systems for in-person voting, the Morgan County Administration Building, 231 Ensign Street 1st Floor, Fort Morgan, will be open for electors wishing to utilize the DAU (Disabled Access Unit) voting machine. This **Voter Service Polling Center** will be open for the 2016 General Election in Morgan County, beginning on Monday, October 17, 2016 through Monday, November 7, 2016 during regular business hours of Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and on Saturday, October 29, 2016 and November 5, 2016 from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. For additional information, call 970-542-3521, option 5.

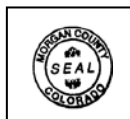
