ELECTION NEWS: November 8, 2016 Presidential General Election will be an all-mail ballot delivery. Ballots will be mailed to all active registered electors the week of October 17, 2016.

How do I return my ballot: After receiving your ballot in the mail you may vote and returned the ballot in the return envelope to:

1. Drop your ballot off at the Morgan County Clerk & Recorder's Office at 231 Ensign Street, Elections Office, located on the first floor, or,
2. Place adequate postage on your ballot return envelope and mail it back. Remember to allow enough time for mail delivery of your voted ballot. All ballots must be returned to the Clerk and Recorder's office by Election Day, November 8, 2016 by 7:00 p.m. in order to be counted, whether by hand delivery or mail delivery, or
3. Drop your ballot in the 24/7 Drive Up Drop Box located in on the east side of the Morgan County Commissioner's office, 218 Kiowa Avenue, Fort Morgan (just west of the Morgan County Administration building, look for the flags!) (no postage necessary)

IT IS NOT NECESSARY TO WAIT UNTIL ELECTION DAY TO VOTE

IMPORTANT DATES FOR 2016 GENERAL ELECTION:

- October 17 – 21, 2016: Ballots will be mailed to all Active eligible electors.
- October 17, 2016 Monday: Last day to submit an application to register to vote through a voter registration drive. (no later than 22 days before the election)
- October 31, 2016, Monday: Last day to submit an application to register to vote through the mail, a voter registration agency, a local driver's license examination facility, or online to receive a ballot in the mail for the General Election. (through the 8th day prior to the election)
- November 1, 2016, Tuesday: Last day to file an absentee ballot application to receive the absentee ballot by mail if you are absent from your home address.
- October 31, 2016, Monday – November 8, 2016, Tuesday: Voters can register to vote, obtain a replacement ballot or drop off their mail in ballots in person at the Morgan County Clerk & Recorder's Office 231 Ensign Street, Elections Department, Fort Morgan, CO 80701

- **Morgan County Clerk and Recorder's Office Election Department** will be open on Saturday, October 29, 2016 and Saturday, November 5 from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. for ballot drop off, replacement ballots.
- **November 8, 2016: ELECTION DAY**
Morgan County Clerk and Recorder's Office is open 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. 231 Ensign Street, (Assembly Room, basement), Fort Morgan, CO
