

Morgan County Voter Information - November 4, 2016

Morgan County Election staff has been very busy processing new registrations and updating existing voter records. Since the deadline has now passed for voters to receive their ballot by mail, we are informing citizens who wish to register to vote, or should need a replacement ballot, to appear in our office located on the first floor of the Morgan County Administration Building, 231 Ensign Street, Fort Morgan between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Our office will also be open and available to citizens on Saturday, November 5, 2016 from 8:00 a.m. to noon. For those voters who may choose to cast their ballot using our voting machines, our office does have two machines set up and available to voters during these hours as well.

On Tuesday, November 8, 2016, Election Day, Morgan County will have three Voter Service Polling Centers available for individuals to register to vote, vote or obtain a replacement ballot. The location of these Vote Centers will be at the Wiggins Fire Hall, 701 Central Avenue, Wiggins; Brush Fairgrounds (Mark Arndt Event Center) 750 Ellsworth, Brush; and the Morgan County Administration Building (Assembly Room, basement), at 231 Ensign Street, Fort Morgan. The hours on Election Day are from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. A reminder to voters, your ballot MUST be in the possession of the Clerk's office no later than 7 p.m. on Election Day, postmarks do NOT count. So please plan accordingly to ensure that our office receives your ballot by 7 p.m. on Tuesday, November 8, Election Day.

Voters have several options to return their ballots this year! We have a new 24 hour Ballot Drop box located just across the alley way from the Administration building which will be available to voters until 7 p.m. on Election Day. We also have a ballot drop box available to voters during regular business hours located on the first floor of the administration building and of course ballot boxes will be available at each of the Voter Service Polling Centers on Election Day.

Please note that the Motor Vehicle Department and the Recording Department will be closed on Tuesday, November 8, for staff to be able to assist with Election Day. We will be opened at 8 a.m. on Wednesday, November 9, to provide customers assistance.

Please get out there and vote, cast your ballot early! The earlier we receive ballots back, the earlier we will be able to provide election results on Election Night!!
