3. To vote for a named candidate, completely fill the oval to the left of your choice. To vote for a write-in candidate, completely fill the oval to the left of the words "Write-in" and legibly print at least the first and last names of an eligible write-in candidate in the write-in area to the right. Vote like this:



WARNING: Any person who, by use of force or other means, unduly influences an eligible elector to vote in any particular manner or to refrain from voting, or who falsely makes, alters, forges, or counterfeits any mail ballot before or after it has been cast, or who destroys, defaces, mutilates, or tampers with a ballot is subject, upon conviction, to imprisonment, to a fine, or to a fine, or both. Briggsdale RE-10J School District Measures

Ballot questions referred by the general assembly or any political subdivision are listed by letter, and ballot questions initiated by the people are listed numerically. A ballot question listed as an "amendment" proposes a change to the Colorado constitution, and a ballot question listed as a "proposition" proposes a change to the Colorado Revised Statutes. A "yes/for" vote on any ballot question is a vote in favor of changing current law or existing circumstances, and a "no/against" vote on any ballot question is a vote against changing current law or existing circumstances.

BALLOT ISSUE 3B

SHALL WELD COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. RE-10J TAXES BE INCREASED UP TO \$645,550 IN 2018 AND ANNUALLY THEREAFTER BY AN AMOUNT THAT REPLACES THE DISTRICT'S EXISTING MILL LEVY OVERRIDE THAT EXPIRES IN 2017 AND IS UP TO THIRTY PERCENT OF THE DISTRICT'S TOTAL PROGRAM AS PROVIDED BY STATE LAW (AS SUCH TERM IS DEFINED IN STATE LAW OR ANY SIMILAR TERMS PROVIDED IN ANY SUCCESSOR PROVISION OF STATE LAW), BY THE LEVY OF PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE DISTRICT'S GENERAL FUND AT A RATE THAT WILL PRODUCE AN AMOUNT UP TO THIRTY PERCENT OF THE DISTRICT'S TOTAL PROGRAM, TO FUND DISTRICT OPERATIONS INCLUDING, AMONG OTHER THINGS,

- RECRUITING AND RETAINING HIGHLY QUALIFIED TEACHERS AND STAFF FOR ESSENTIAL EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS,
- REPLACING OUTDATED TEXTBOOKS AND EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS,
- REDUCING THE TEACHER-TO-STUDENT RATIO SO TEACHERS CAN FOCUS ON STUDENTS AND THEIR NEEDS, AND
- PROVIDING PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE AND UPKEEP TO EXISTING FACILITIES AND BUS FLEET,
